

States and Educator Preparation Programs (EPPs) interested in using edTPA may have different timelines for policy development and for preparation programs to prepare for full implementation. It is understood that the process to develop policy in a state may take several years, and campuses may wish to scale up incrementally. Accordingly, the *edTPA Usage Plan* is offered to provide various levels of support to state education agencies and preparation programs in their efforts toward adopting edTPA.

Additionally, the *edTPA Usage Plan* is intended to be sensitive to the unique needs of potential state and educator preparation programs in adopting edTPA. All usage plan levels (introductory, exploratory, and implementation) provide a pathway for educative use and sustainability of edTPA.
